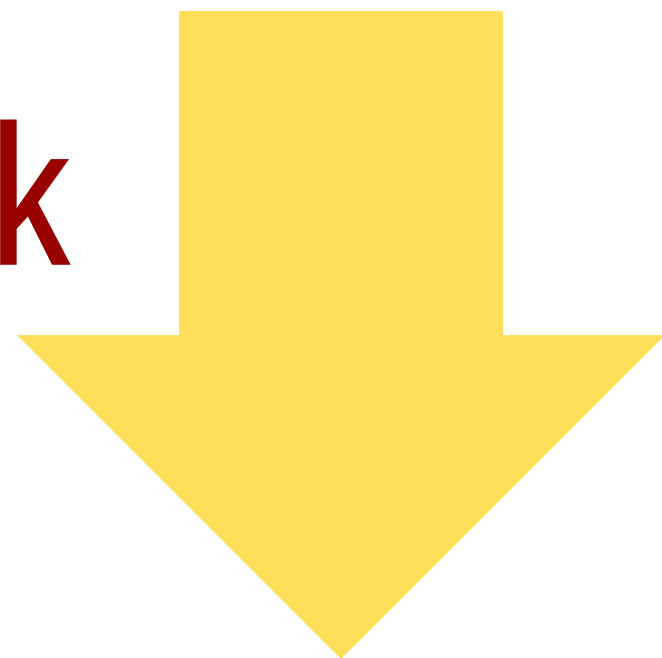

GET BACK YOUR TIME!

El ensayo argumentativo

- ★ Body paragraph 2 follows the same pattern.
- ★ Topic sentence, explanation, quote (from a different source)

El ensayo argumentativo

- ★ ¡Escribir la introducción es sencillo si aprendes la fórmula!
- ★ Empieza con una frase general para introducir el tema del ensayo.
- ★ Después, presenta algunos de los diferentes puntos de vista sobre el asunto. Dos de ellos deben apoyar tu argumento y uno debe apoyar el argumento opuesto.
- ★ Termina tu párrafo introductorio con una CLARA declaración de TÚ postura.

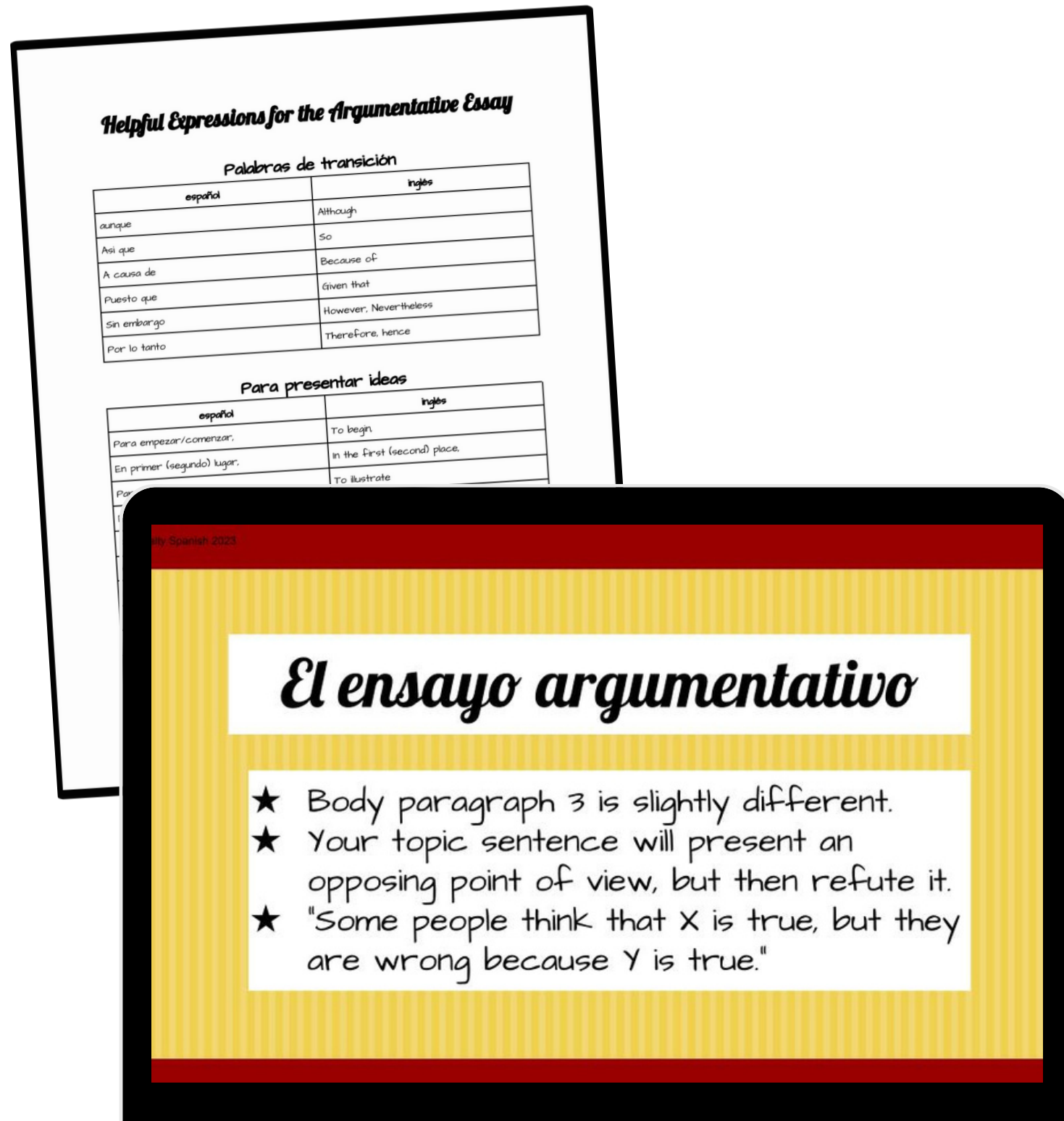

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General Hints

- ★ Be sure to use your own words. Don't get carried away with over-quoting the sources.
- ★ This is a formal essay. Keep your register formal. Avoid using the tú form.
- ★ Use the se impersonal to make generalized statements.

More Slides

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Pistas Generales

- ★ Asegúrate que hay una transición fluida entre una idea y otra, o un párrafo y otro.
- ★ Usa palabras de transición para ayudarte con esto. Mira el recurso de vocabulario al final de esta presentación.

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Sí y No

- ★ No uses inglés.
- ★ No escribas párrafos que defiendan el otro punto de vista. Recuerda - ¡estás negando el otro punto de vista!
- ★ No uses mucho tiempo repasando los materiales. En cambio, subraya las fuentes escritas mientras lees y toma apuntes mientras escuchas.

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Do's and Don'ts

- ★ Don't use English.
- ★ Don't write a paragraph that defends the other viewpoint. Remember- you are negating the other viewpoint!.
- ★ Don't use too much time reviewing the sources. Instead, underline the print sources as you read and take notes as you listen.

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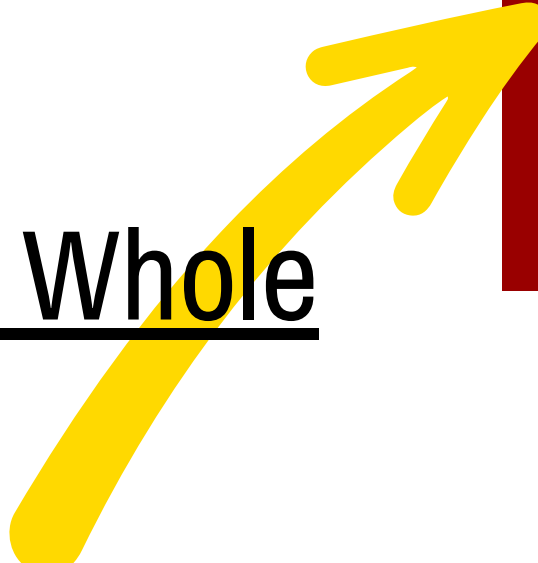
Some hints about the quotes

- ★ When you make reference or quote the sources, be sure that you are offering evidence that supports your point of view.
- ★ You should not use quotes as a way to summarize what a source says, but rather to reinforce your viewpoint.
