## Guided Conversation #1

**Instrucciones:** You will participate in a guided conversation between 2 friends. One friend has recently taken a trip for a vacation. You will be provided with general prompts so you have an idea of what to say.

**Persona A:** Your job is to ask the questions. \*If you're ready for a challenge, add in a reaction to what your partner tells you. You could share a similar experience too before you ask the next question!

**Persona B:** Your job is to answer the questions with as much detail as you can!

Persona A: Begin the conversation by greeting your partner and asking a question about their last vacation.

Persona B: Greet your partner and answer the question.

Persona A: Will ask a question about how you got to your destination.

Persona B: Answer the question with 2 details.

Persona A: will ask a question about what kind of place you stayed while on vacation.

Persona B: Answer the question with 2 details.

Persona A: Will ask a question about what you did while you were on vacation.

Persona B: Answer the question with details.

Persona A: Will ask you if you were happy with your trip.

Persona B: Answer the question and explain why.

**Instrucciones:** You will participate in a guided conversation between a customer service provider and a client. The client has recently taken a trip for a vacation. The customer service provider wants to know what went well and what went wrong on your trip. You will be provided with general prompts so you have an idea of what to say.

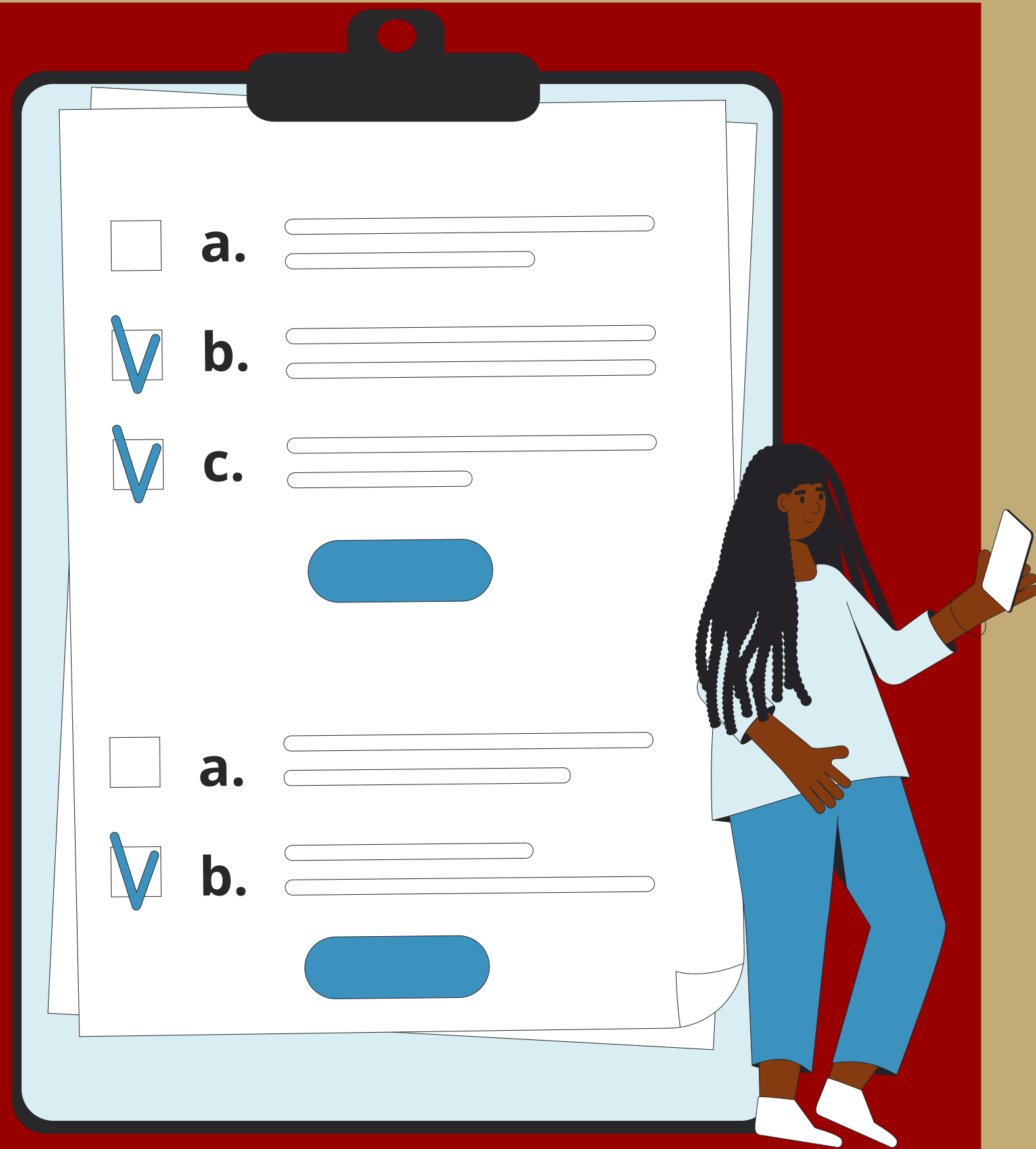

**Instrucciones:** You will participate in a guided conversation between you and your older sister/brother. Your sibling is graduating from high school, but they're unsure about what they will do next. You will be provided with general prompts so you have an idea of what to say.

**Primary Time Frame:** Future

|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Older sibling: Greets you and asks a question about what to do after graduation.       |
| Younger sibling: Greet her and answer her question.                                    |
| Older sibling: Tell your sibling what some people do instead of going to college.      |
| Younger sibling: React and ask a follow up question.                                   |
| Older sibling: Explain an idea you have for yourself for after college.                |
| Younger sibling: Express disagreement, but give another suggestion.                    |
| Older sibling: Ask a follow up question about your suggestion.                         |
| Younger sibling: Answer her question with 2 details.                                   |
| Older sibling: Bring the conversation to an end and say where you are going right now. |
| Younger sibling: Give her some encouragement and end the conversation.                 |
